Hello Charlton Heston Academy Parent,

This letter is to inform all parents that CHA will schedule an e-learning day for all students on Monday, March 1, 2021. Please allow me to explain.....

As you may be aware, the second dose of the COVID vaccine will be administered to CHA staff members tomorrow.

You may also have heard that second doses of the vaccine have often resulted in symptoms of illnesses for some people. For example, some people have become ill with flu-like symptoms, fevers, etc.

So, it is in the best interest of staff members, students, and the school community to move Monday to an e-learning day for all students.

The building will remain open for the main office staff, and the facilities department. Staff members who are healthy are able to use the building and respective resources if needed, However, students are not permitted in the building during instructional hours on Monday. The Academy will simply not have adequate staff members present in the building to teach and monitor students. However, the Academy will continue with after school activities such as athletic practices and games. We are simply moving to e-learning because there is a likelihood that we would not have enough healthy staff members to operate the school. LSSU classes will continue as scheduled. The instructors for LSSU classes will contact students to schedule e-learning, ZOOM or another online class instead of face-to-face if they choose to. Again, students will be contacted directly by the LSSU instructors.
