2022-2023 Learning Loss Plan (PA 144 Section 98C)

Charlton Heston Academy (CHA) expects to be awarded \$36.75 per student (742 students) for a total of \$27,268.50 for the Learning Loss Grant for 2022-2023. This allocation will focus on the learning loss in mathematics resulting from the COVID-19 Pandemic and related issues.

Charlton Heston Academy continues to provide exhaustive continuous improvement for all students in all subject areas. In addition to the general education programming and many supplemental academic support/programs, CHA will provide learning loss support programs to 100 middle school students in grades 6-8. Specifically the plan will consist of:

- One full-time math interventionist to provide one on one and/or small group instruction based on learning gaps
- NWEA results from fall 2022 have been considered, along with teacher recommendations to create the list of students receiving this support
- 25 students will be referred to the interventionist each of the four academic quarters
- The effectiveness of the program will be measured through the MATH NWEA results (student growth percentile, scaled score, and national percentile ranking).
