



CHA Student Dress Code

- All students must wear **khaki colored** pants, skirts, shorts, or jumpers. Clothing must be clean and with no visible holes. Shorts and skirts should be a manageable length (must be at least mid-thigh or fingertip length). No khaki sweatpants are permitted.
- All students **K-8** must wear **polo-style shirts** (short or long sleeve), solid color only corresponding to the following grade levels. While the “Charlton Heston Academy” logo may be embroidered on shirts, it is not required. No other logos are allowed on shirts. Shirts should remain tucked in, and students are permitted to wear long-sleeve undershirts of any of the following solid colors: red, white, blue, or black.
 - o Child Care and Pre-K (Optional): **Blue**
 - o K - 2nd Grades: **Blue**
 - o 3rd - 5th Grades: **Red**
 - o 6th - 8th Grades: **Black**
 - o 9th - 12th Grades: **CHA logo shirt**
- All students are permitted to wear short or long-sleeved **cardigans, V-neck style sweaters, crew neck, half zip sweaters and sweatshirts (solid colored hoodies are also allowed for all grades)** in any of the following solid colors: red, white, blue or black. Sweatshirts or hoodies must be plain or include the CHA logo. **Hoods must be down, and any type of hats are not permitted.**
- Flip flops, sandals, and slides are not permitted.
- Students are not permitted to draw on their skin with ink or other materials, and no blankets are permitted.
- Students are permitted to bring additional and/or different clothing for **physical education class** starting in 6th grade, but such clothing must be appropriate for school and in good taste.
- Students are required to wear their school uniforms to and from school when riding the school buses. Uniforms are required while transitioning between buildings.
