



CHA Student Dress Down Dress Code

Dress Down Days at Charlton Heston Academy are a privilege for eligible students, allowing casual attire while ensuring appropriateness for the educational environment.

- Clothing must cover the chest, midriff, back, buttocks, and undergarments, and should be clean, neat, and safe for participation in school activities. Prohibited items include crop tops, strapless or backless tops, cleavage-exposing shirts, see-through clothing, and tank tops with narrow straps.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be at least mid-thigh or fingertip length, and pants should sit at the waist.
- Closed-toed shoes are required and must be worn all day. Flip-flops, sandals, and slides are not permitted
- Clothing that promotes drugs, violence, or hate speech is forbidden.
- Hats, hoods, and sunglasses are not permitted inside unless medically approved.

Administrators can determine the appropriateness of attire, and students may be asked to change if guidelines are not met, which may result in the loss of Dress Down Day privileges. The objective is to maintain a respectful and positive learning environment.
